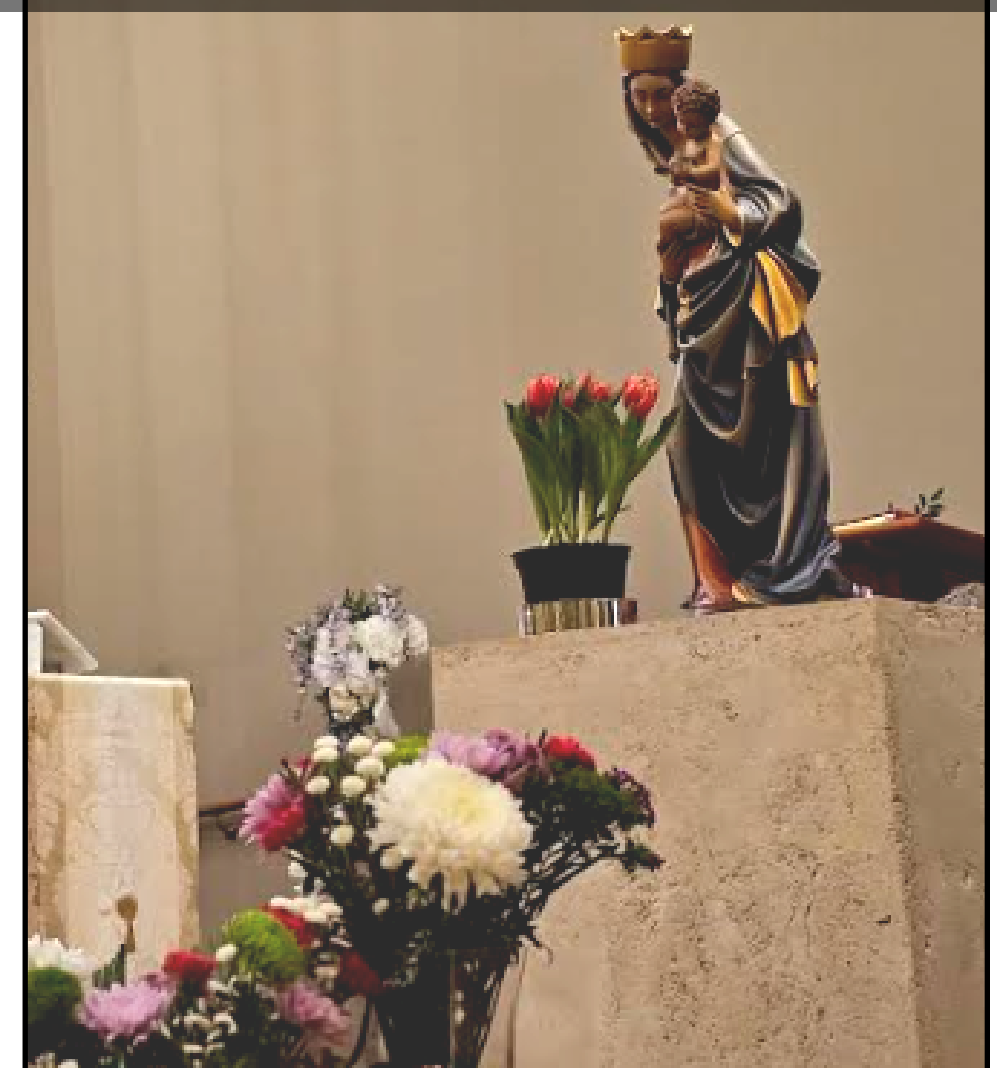

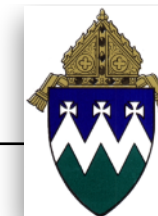

Lord's Prayer #9-Deliver us from evil
